Code of Conduct

- 1) Parents are required to furnish transportation to and from practice sessions and games. A legal guardian or an appointed adult must be present at all NPYL activities for each player. In the event that situation is deemed problematic, a coach and/or board member may require that a legal guardian be present at all times.
- 2) At no time should a spectator or non-player enter the field of play. This is cause for immediate ejection by the umpires or board members.
- 3) Swearing or verbal abuse by anyone towards players, coaches, umpires, board members, or spectators will not be tolerated at ANY time. If this occurs during a game, the umpire, coach or NPYL Board Member may request the individual(s) to leave the field and/or an automatic out may be assessed for any violations stated herein.
- 4) Physical violence or threats of physical violence by anyone toward players, coaches, umpires, board members, or spectators will not be tolerated. Violators may be banned from attending NPYL activities.
- 5) All IHSAA, NPHS, and NPYL Rules and Regulations apply to all NPYL activities. Parents and participants are to comply, i.e. NO weapons, NO alcohol, No drugs or NO contraband.
- 6) There will be absolutely no smoking or use of alcoholic beverages on or around the premises of the NPYL or its activities.
- 7) There are to be NO PETS on school premises. If you have a pet on school grounds you will be asked to remove the pet from the grounds.
- 8) If any individual is ejected from a game or practice for violation of one or more of the above rules, they may not attend the next league game. If a spectator is ejected from a second league activity, they may be banned from NPYL activities for the rest of the season.

The Board reserves the right to review this on a case-by-case basis.
