

## Code of Conduct

1) Parents are required to furnish transportation to and from practice sessions and games. A legal guardian or an appointed adult must be present at all NPYL activities for each player. In the event that situation is deemed problematic, a coach and/or board member may require that a legal guardian be present at all times.

2) At no time should a spectator or non-player enter the field of play. This is cause for immediate ejection by the umpires or board members.

3) Swearing or verbal abuse by anyone towards players, coaches, umpires, board members, or spectators will not be tolerated at ANY time. If this occurs during a game, the umpire, coach or NPYL Board Member may request the individual(s) to leave the field and/or an automatic out may be assessed for any violations stated herein.

4) Physical violence or threats of physical violence by anyone toward players, coaches, umpires, board members, or spectators will not be tolerated. Violators may be banned from attending NPYL activities.

5) All IHSAA, NPHS, and NPYL Rules and Regulations apply to all NPYL activities. Parents and participants are to comply, i.e. NO weapons, NO alcohol, No drugs or NO contraband.

6) There will be absolutely no smoking or use of alcoholic beverages on or around the premises of the NPYL or its activities.

7) There are to be NO PETS on school premises. If you have a pet on school grounds you will be asked to remove the pet from the grounds.

8) If any individual is ejected from a game or practice for violation of one or more of the above rules, they may not attend the next league game. If a spectator is ejected from a second league activity, they may be banned from NPYL activities for the rest of the season.

The Board reserves the right to review this on a case-by-case basis.
